The first year (214 hours):

Clinical training in Maternal and Child health, School health and Elderly, Epidemiology of Communicable and Non-Communicable diseases, Environmental, Occupation Medicine, Health care services and quality control, Health education

Final examination

The purpose of the examination is to evaluate the ability of the candidate to be a leader in a community health team and in promotion of community health. Mainly, the examination will be in the form of Problem solving type
